# **Graduate Diploma in Computer Science**

#### 1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol, a person must —

- (a) either—
  - (i) hold an approved degree; in the same discipline; or
  - (ii) hold the Graduate Certificate in Computer Science; or
  - (iii) have completed post-secondary study and 2 years relevant work experience approved by the executive dean; and
- (b) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record, the person is suitably qualified for admission.

### 2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units from the MCompSc course list, comprising—

- (a) 8 units from part A; and
- (b) the balance from part A or part B or a combination of both or other courses approved by the executive dean.

# 3 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that an associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for previous study is 8 units.
