PROGRAM RULES



Master of Clinical Pharmacy

1 Definitions

In these rules—

recency of practice means a person has practiced as a registered pharmacist for a minimum of 300 hours in the last two years.

2 Enrolment requirements

- (1) To enrol in the program, a person must—
 - (a) hold an approved degree; and
 - (b) be registered as a pharmacist in Australia or overseas; and
 - (c) have completed 2 years' full-time (or equivalent) relevant professional work experience; and
 - (d) have demonstrated recency of practice; and
 - (e) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record and prior work experience, the person is qualified for admission.
- (2) In addition to the requirements in subrule (1), students progressing from the Graduate Diploma in Clinical Pharmacy must have gained a GPA of 5 in that program.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MClinPharm list.
