

# **Master of Mineral Resources**

## 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*pre-2015 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2015; *pre-2017 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program after 31 December 2014 but before 1 January 2017.

## 2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) hold a Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Mineral Resources from the university, or
- (b) hold an approved degree in the same discipline.

## 3 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in only one approved field.

## 4 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MMinRes list, comprising—

- (a) 8 units from part A; and
- (b) 4 units from part C; and
- (c) 12 units from part A or part B or part C or a combination of these parts.

## 5 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 8 units.

## 6 Transitional

- (1) A pre-2015 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2014.
- (2) A pre-2017 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2016.
