

## Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (24 units)

### 1 Application

These rules apply to students who are enrolled in the Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (24 units) program.

*Note* a separate set of rules apply to students who are enrolled in the Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (32 units) program.

### 2 Definitions

In these rules—

**field of study** means an approved combination of 8 units from Part C of the MTHEM (24 units) list.

**MTHEM (24 units) list** means the course list for the Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (24 units) program.

**MTHEM (32 units) list** means the course list for the Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (32 units) program.

**pre-2015 student** means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2015.

### 3 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent, in the same discipline, approved by the executive dean, with a GPA of 4.5.

### 4 Field of study

A student may undertake the program in one or two approved fields.

### 5 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the MTHEM (24 units) list, comprising—
  - (a) 6 units from Part A; and
  - (b) 2 units from Part B; and
  - (c) 16 units from Part C or Part D, which may comprise one or two fields of study.
- (2) No more than 4 units of other courses approved by the executive dean may be included in rule (1)(c).

### 6 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 12 units.

### 7 Special rules

#### 7.1 Early exit in a suite of programs

For the purposes of [PPL 3.50.11 Awards](#), this program is not considered part of the tourism, hotel and event management suite of postgraduate coursework programs.

#### 7.2 Award of the Graduate Certificate in Tourism, Hotel and Event Management

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 8 units from the MTHEM (24 units) list may be awarded a Graduate Certificate in Tourism, Hotel and Event Management.

### **7.3 Course limitations**

No credit towards the MTHEM (24 units) program will be granted for completing courses from part A of the MTHEM (32 units) list.

## **8 Transitional**

- 8.1 Students enrolled in the international hotel and tourism management suite of postgraduate programs as at 31 December 2012 who have completed up to 8 units may be permitted to enrol in this program subject to meeting rule 3 *Enrolment requirements*.
- 8.2 A pre-2015 student must complete the program under the rules in force on 31 December 2014, or may complete the program under the current rules subject to meeting rule 3 *Enrolment requirements*.
