PROGRAM RULES



Bachelor of Agricultural Science

1 Definitions

In these rules—

major means an approved combination of 16 units from part B of the BAgrSc course list. *residential school* means a period of attendance on campus to carry out components of a course which are not delivered externally.

2 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in an approved major.

3 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 48 units from the BAgrSc course list, comprising—
 - (a) 16 units for part A; and
 - (b) 16 units for a major from part B; and
 - (c) 16 units from part B or part C or a combination of both.
- (2) For subrule (1), a student must gain
 - (a) a minimum of 12 units of level 3 or higher courses; and
 - (b) no more than 24 units of level 1 courses.

4 Special rules

4.1 Residential schools

If enrolled in external mode, a student will be required to undertake residential schools for certain courses.
