

Bachelor of Agricultural Science (Honours)

1 Enrolment requirements

1.1 Eligibility

To be eligible for admission to the program, a person must—

- (a) have both—
 - (i) completed the program requirements of the Bachelor of Sustainable Agriculture or Bachelor of Agricultural Science at the University, with a GPA of 5; and
 - (ii) satisfied any additional requirements set by the executive dean; or
- (b) satisfied the executive dean that the person is qualified to undertake honours—
 - (i) based on the person's academic records; and
 - (ii) subject to completion of additional work, if set.

1.2 Selection

- (1) The head of school may limit places depending on project availability.
- (2) Once eligibility is established, entry is via a competitive selection process based on GPA.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units in accordance with the BAgrSc(Hons) course list.

3 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the grade point average of the results obtained by a student in the first attempt at all courses in the program.
