

## Bachelor of Laws (Honours) (LLB(Hons))

### 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*general elective courses* means non-LAWS-coded courses from any undergraduate program at the University approved by the executive dean;

*pre-2017 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2017.

### 2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units from the LLB(Hons) course list comprising—

- (a) 40 units for part A,
- (b) 16 units from part B, and
- (c) 8 units of general elective courses.

### 3 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 32 units.

### 4 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the grade point average of the grades obtained by a student in the first attempt at all LAWS courses at level 2 or higher that contribute to the program.

A pre-2017 student must complete the program under the rules in force on 31 December 2016.
