PROGRAM RULES



Bachelor of Arts / Bachelor of Education (Secondary)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

curriculum studies courses means courses listed in parts C and D of the BEd(Sec) section of the BA/BEd(Sec) course list;

major has the meaning prescribed in <u>PPL 3.20.08 Program Design – Policy</u>;

pre-2017 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2017; *pre-2018 student* means a student who enrolled in the program before 1 January 2018; *specialisation* has the meaning prescribed in PPL 3.20.08 *Program Design* – Policy.

2 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units, comprising—
 - (a) 32 units from the BA section of the BA/BEd(Sec) course list, comprising—
 - (i) 2 majors from part A; or
 - (ii) a major from part A and a major from part B; or
 - (iii) the specialisation in Music from part A; and
 - (b) 32 units from the BEd(Sec) section of the BA/BEd(Sec) course list, comprising—
 - (i) 16 units for part A; and
 - (ii) 8 units for part B; and
 - (iii) 4 units from part C; and
 - (iv) 4 units from parts C or D.
- (2) Unless a different intention appears in these rules, a student must comply with the program rules for both degrees.

3 Field of study

A student may not undertake both the Music major and Popular Music and Technology major in the BA component of the dual program.

4 Course pre-enrolment approval

Course pre-enrolment approval is required for BEd(Sec) courses.

5 Special rules

5.1 Progression through program

A student must complete the requirements for the BA before enrolling in courses from parts B, C or D (if any) of the BEd(Sec) section of the BA/BEd(Sec) course list.

5.2 Specialist requirements

Students in their final year of the BA/BEd(Sec) program must choose curriculum studies courses that correspond to each of the majors completed in the BA component of their program or, for the specialisation in Music, two curriculum studies courses in music.

5.3 Blue card

At the start of the program, a student must obtain a blue card and thereafter hold a current blue card for the duration of the program.

5.4 LANTITE test

Prior to graduation, a student must successfully complete the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (LANTITE).

5.5 Award of the Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor of Learning Studies (Secondary)

- (1) A student who meets all program requirements for the BA/BEd(Sec) under rule 2 but does not meet the LANTITE test requirement under rule 5.4, may be awarded the Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor of Learning Studies (Secondary).
- (2) Subject to rule 5.5(1) a student who has completed the Music specialisation in the BA component of the BA/BEd(Sec) may be awarded the Bachelor of Arts with a specialisation in Music.
- (3) The Bachelor of Learning Studies (Secondary) is not approved for teacher registration in Australia.

6 Transitional

- (1) A pre-2017 student may complete the program under the rules in force on 31 December 2016.
- (2) A pre-2018 student must comply with the requirements of rules 5.4 and 5.5.
