

Graduate Diploma in Psychological Practice

1 Definitions

In these rules—

practicum course means a course containing a practical component where students gain supervised experience in a workplace setting.

2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a student must—

- (a) hold an approved masters or higher degree in psychology or equivalent; and
- (b) hold current registration as a general psychologist with an area of practice endorsement, as identified by the Psychology Board of Australia; and
- (c) satisfy the executive dean that the student has sufficient training and experience.

3 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in an approved field of study.

4 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units in accordance with the GDipPsyPrac course list in the approved field of study.

5 Special rules

5.1 Practicum

A student who commences but does not successfully complete a practicum course may re-enrol in that course only if approved by the executive dean.

5.2 Psychologist Registration

A student must have general registration with the Psychology Board of Australia for the duration of enrolment in the program.
