PROGRAM RULES



Master of Advanced Nursing

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program a person must—

- (a) hold an approved bachelor degree or equivalent in the same discipline;
- (b) satisfy the executive dean that the person has gained at least 1 years' recent and relevant experience in working as a Registered Nurse or equivalent.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from the Master of Advanced Nursing (MAdvNurs) course list, comprising—

- (a) 14units from part A; and
- (b) 4 units from part B; and
- (c) 6 units from part C.

3 Special rules

3.1 Continuous enrolment

Unless approved by the executive dean, a student must undertake the program without interruption.

3.2 Early exit in a suite of programs

- (1) A student who withdraws from the program after completing 14 units from part A and 2 units from part C of the MAdvNurs course list may be awarded a Graduate Diploma in Nursing.
- (2) Treat the Graduate Certificate in Nursing as part of the Advanced Nursing suite of programs.

3.3 Transitional

(1) A student enrolled in the Master of Nursing at 31 December 2016 will be permitted to enrol in the Master of Advanced Nursing.
