

Master of Computer Science (Management)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

partner institution means an overseas institution with whom The University of Queensland has a formal agreement as an official partner with the Master of Computer Science (Management) program.

2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must —

- (a) hold—
 - (i) an approved degree in the same discipline; or
 - (ii) a Graduate Certificate in Computer Science or equivalent; or
 - (iii) a Graduate Diploma in Computer Science or equivalent; or;
- (b) have successfully completed at least three years of study towards an approved program at a partner institution; and
- (c) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record, the person is suitably qualified for admission.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 32 units in accordance with the MCompSc(Man) course list.

4 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that an associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for previous study is 16 units.
