# **PROGRAM RULES**



# **Master of Conservation Biology (MConsBiol)**

#### 1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program a person must hold an approved degree in biology with a specialisation in ecology, evolution, zoology or botany (or equivalent) or an undergraduate degree in environmental science.

# 2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 24 units from part A of the MConsBiol course list.

# 3 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 8 units.

# 4 Special rules

# 4.1 Award of the Graduate Certificate in Conservation Biology

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 8 units may be awarded a Graduate Certificate in Conservation Biology.
