



## PROGRAM RULES

### Master of Economics and Public Policy (32 Units)

#### 1 Application

These rules apply to students who are enrolled in the Master of Economics and Public Policy (32 units) program.

*Note: a separate set of rules apply to students who are enrolled in the Master of Economics and Public Policy (24 units) program.*

#### 2 Definitions

In these rules –

**MEconPP (#32) list** means the course list for the Master of Economics and Public Policy (32 units) program.

#### 3 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must hold –

- (a) a bachelor degree or equivalent as approved by the executive dean with a GPA of 4.5; or
- (b) hold a Graduate Certificate in Economic Studies or Graduate Diploma in Economics from the university, or equivalent, with a GPA of 4.5.

#### 4 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 32 units from the MEconPP (#32) list comprising –

- (a) 24 units from Part A of the list; and
- (b) 8 units from Part B of the list.

#### 5 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 16 units.

#### 6 Special rules

##### 6.1 Early exit in a suite of programs

For the purposes of [PPL 3.50.11 Awards](#), the Graduate Certificate in Economics Studies and Graduate Diploma in Economics are taken to be part of the Economics and Public Policy suite of programs.

#### 7 Transitional

Students enrolled in the Master of Economics and Public Policy (Advanced) as at 31 December 2014 may be permitted to enrol in this program.
