

Master of Pharmaceutical Industry Practice

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) hold either—
 - (i) an approved bachelor degree in science, engineering, medical science, or equivalent; or
 - (ii) the Graduate Certificate in Pharmaceutical Industry Practice from the University; and
- (b) satisfy the executive dean that, based on the person's academic record and prior work experience, the person is qualified for admission.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 32 units in accordance with the MPharmIndPrac course list.

3 Special rules

3.1 Award of the Graduate Diploma in Pharmaceutical Industry Practice

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 16 units, comprised of the courses listed in year 1 of the MPharmIndPrac course list, may be awarded the Graduate Diploma in Pharmaceutical Industry Practice.
