

## Bachelor of Health Sciences (Honours) (BHlthSc(Hons))

### 1 Enrolment requirements

#### 1.1 Eligibility

To be eligible for admission to the program, a person must either—

- (a) have—
  - (i) completed the program requirements of the Bachelor of Health Sciences (BHlthSc) from this University, and
  - (ii) met the GPA requirement set by the head of school; or
- (b) satisfied the executive dean that the person is qualified to undertake the program—
  - (i) based on the person's academic records; and
  - (ii) subject to completion of additional work if set.

#### 1.2 Selection

- (1) The head of school may limit places depending on supervisor availability.
- (2) Once eligibility is established, entry is via a competitive selection process based on GPA.

### 2 Program requirements

To complete the program a student must complete 16 units from the BHlthSc(Hons) course list.

### 3 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the grade obtained by a student in the first attempt at the course in the program.

### 4 Special rules

#### 4.1 Maximum enrolment period

A full-time honours student must complete the program within 2 consecutive semesters, and a part-time honours student must complete the program within 4 consecutive semesters.
