

## Bachelor of Music (Honours) (BMus(Hons))

### 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*chosen instrument* means the instrument the student wishes to use for the practical study sections of the program and includes the human voice;

*pre-2016 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2016;

*pre-2017 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program after 31 December 2015 but before 1 January 2017;

*pre-2020 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program after 31 December 2016 but before 1 January 2020.

### 2 Enrolment requirements

A person must undertake an audition and interview test set by the head of school.

### 3 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units, comprising—
  - (a) 48 units from the BMus(Hons) course list, comprising—
    - (i) 26 units for core courses, and
    - (ii) 12 units from flexible core courses, and
    - (iii) 10 units for research courses; and
  - (b) 16 units of general elective courses from the BMus(Hons) course list or other undergraduate course list(s).
- (2) Of the 64 units required for the program as set out in rule 3(1), a student must complete no more than 24 units of level 1 courses.
- (3) Before starting the program, a student must obtain approval from the head of school for their chosen instrument. The head of school must approve subsequent changes to the chosen instrument.

### 4 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the grade point average over 24 units of courses at level 3 or higher, comprising—

- (a) 8 units from core courses;
- (b) 6 units of the highest graded courses at level 3 or higher from flexible core courses; and
- (c) 10 units from research courses.

### 5 Special rules

#### 5.1 Interruption of program

A student who has not maintained enrolment in consecutive semesters may be required to pass examinations and fulfil conditions set by the head of school.

#### 5.2 Award of the Bachelor of Music Studies

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 48 units, including at least 8 units of courses at level 3 or higher, may be awarded the Bachelor of Music Studies.

## **6 Transitional**

- (1) A pre-2016 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2015.
- (2) A pre-2017 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2016.
- (3) A pre-2020 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2019.
