

Bachelor of Regional and Town Planning (Honours) (BRTP(Hons))

1 Definitions

In these rules—

pre-2021 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2021.

2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) have completed at least 42 units towards the Bachelor of Regional and Town Planning (BRTP) (2063) program, including PLAN3001; and
- (b) either—
 - (i) have a GPA of 5.5 in courses that can be credited towards the BRTP(Hons) program; or
 - (ii) satisfy the head of school that the person is qualified for admission.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units from the BRTP(Hons) course list, comprising—

- (a) 50 units for core courses,
- (b) 10 units of research courses, and
- (c) 0-4 units of program elective courses, and
- (d) 0-4 units of general elective courses.

4 Transitional

A pre-2021 student may choose to complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2020.
