

## Bachelor of Humanities / Bachelor of Laws (Honours)

### 1 Definitions

In these rules—

*extended major* means an approved combination of 24 units from part B of the BHum course list.

### 2 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 88 units, comprising—
  - (a) 32 units from the BHum course list, comprising—
    - (i) 8 units for part A; and
    - (ii) 24 units from part B; and
  - (b) 56 units from the LLB(Hons) course list, comprising—
    - (i) 40 units for part A; and
    - (ii) 16 units from part B.
- (2) Unless a different intention appears in these rules, a student must comply with the program rules for both degrees.

### 3 Field of study

A student must undertake the BHum part of the dual program in an approved BHum extended major.

### 4 Special rules

#### 4.1 Award of the Bachelor of Humanities

A student who withdraws from the program having completed the requirements for the Bachelor of Humanities degree may be awarded a Bachelor of Humanities.
