

Bachelor of Mathematics / Bachelor of Commerce (BMath/BCom)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

BCom major means a prescribed combination of 16 units from part B of the BCom course list;

BMath major means a prescribed combination of 16 units from the major section of the BMath course list.

2 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units comprising—
 - (a) 32 units from the BMath course list, comprising—
 - (i) 12 units for core courses, and
 - (ii) 16 units for a BMath major, and
 - (iii) 4 units from the BMath course list; and
 - (b) 32 units from the BCom course list, comprising—
 - (i) 14 units from part A (excluding ECON1310), and
 - (ii) 16 units for a BCom major, and
 - (iii) 2 units from parts B or C.
- (2) Unless a different intention appears in these rules a student must comply with the program rules for both constituent degrees.
