

Bachelor of Music (Honours) / Bachelor of Arts (BMus(Hons)/BA)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

BA extended major means a prescribed combination of 24 units from the plans section of the BA course list;

BA major means a prescribed combination of 16 units from the plans section of the BA course list;

BA minor means a prescribed combination of 8 units from the plans section of the BA course list;

plan means a minor, major or extended major in the BA;

pre-2016 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2016;

pre-2020 student means a student who first enrolled in the program after 31 December 2015 but before 1 January 2020;

pre-2021 student means a student who first enrolled in the program after 31 December 2019 but before 1 January 2021.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 80 units, comprising—

- (a) 48 units from the BMus(Hons) course list, comprising—
 - (i) 26 units for core courses, and
 - (ii) 12 units from flexible core courses, and
 - (iii) 10 units for research courses; and
- (b) 32 units from the BA course list, comprising—
 - (i) two majors, or
 - (ii) both—
 - (A) 24 units for an extended major, and
 - (B) 8 units for a minor.

3 Program plan

A student may not undertake the Music, Music Psychology, or Popular Music and Technology plans in the BA component of the dual program.

4 Transitional

- (1) A pre-2016 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2015.
- (2) A pre-2020 student may complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2019.
- (3) A pre-2021 student may complete the program under the rules in force at the time of enrolment.
