PROGRAM RULES



Graduate Certificate in Medicine

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) either—
 - (i) hold an approved degree in medicine, nursing or medical science, or related field; or
 - (ii) have an equivalent combination of work experience and/or other training in the field of nursing; and
- (b) satisfy the executive dean that they have completed two years full-time (or equivalent) post-qualification clinical practice.

2 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in an approved field.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 8 units from the GCMed course list comprising -

- (a) 6 units from part A; and
- (b) 2 units from part B

4 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 4 units.

5 Special rules

5.1 Blue Card

- (1) Before commencing the program, a student must provide evidence of a valid Blue Card (or equivalent professional registration); and
- (2) students must hold a valid Blue Card (or equivalent professional registration) for the duration of their enrolment in the program.
