

## Graduate Certificate in Mental Health

### 1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) both—
  - (i) hold an approved degree in the same discipline; and
  - (ii) have completed one year full-time (or equivalent) work experience in a mental health setting, as approved by the executive dean; or
- (b) both—
  - (i) hold an approved degree in a different discipline; and
  - (ii) have completed two years' full-time (or equivalent) work experience in a mental health setting, as approved by the executive dean; or
- (c) both—
  - (i) have completed post-secondary study; and
  - (ii) have completed five years' full-time (or equivalent) work experience in a mental health setting, as approved by the executive dean.

### 2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 8 units from the GCMH course list.

### 3 Special rules

#### 3.1 Blue Card

- (a) Before commencing the program, a student must provide evidence of a valid Blue Card (or equivalent professional registration); and
- (b) students must hold a valid Blue Card (or equivalent professional registration) for the duration of their enrolment in the program.
