PROGRAM RULES



Graduate Diploma in Environmental Management

1 Definitions

In these rules—

pre-2015 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2015. *pre-2019 student* means a student who first enrolled in the program on or after 1 January 2015 and before 1 January 2019.

2 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (a) have completed the Graduate Certificate in Environmental Management; or
- (b) hold an approved degree.

3 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units from the MEnvMan course list, comprising—

- (a) 4 units for part B; and
- (b) 6 units from part C; and
- (c) 6 units from part A or part D or a combination of these parts, or other courses approved by the executive dean.

4 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 6 units.

5 Transitional

- (1) A pre-2015 student may choose to complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2014.
- (2) A pre-2019 student may choose to complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2018.
