### **PROGRAM RULES**



#### **Master of Architecture**

# 1 Enrolment requirements

- (1) To enrol in the program, a person must hold—
  - (a) the BArchDes from this university or an approved bachelor degree in architecture (or equivalent), with a GPA of 4.5; or
  - (b) both—
    - (i) the BArchDes from this university or an approved bachelor degree in architecture (or equivalent), with a GPA of 4.0; and
    - (ii) 6-months postgraduate full-time work experience (or equivalent), approved by the executive dean.
- (2) In addition to subrule (1), applicants holding qualifications other than the BArchDes from this university must satisfy the executive dean that, based on the applicant's academic record, the applicant is suitably qualified for admission.

# 2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 32 units from the MArch course list comprising—

- (a) 8 units from part A; and
- (b) 4 units from part C; and
- (c) 8 units from part D; and
- (d) 12 units from part B or part C or a combination of both.

### 3 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 10 units.
