

Master of Medicine (MMed)

1 Enrolment requirements

To enrol in the program, a person must-

- (a) hold an approved degree in medicine, and
- (b) have completed two years full-time (or equivalent) post-qualification clinical practice, approved by the executive dean, and
- (c) have access to, and any necessary permissions for, the use of appropriate and sufficient clinical cases in order to complete the program.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 16 units from the Master of Medicine course list, comprising—

- (a) 6 units for part A,
- (b) 2 units from part B, and
- (c) 8 units from part C.

3 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 4 units.

4 Special rules

4.1 Professional registration

Before commencing the program, and for the duration of their enrolment in the program, a student must comply with professional registration requirements within their jurisdiction of practice.
