

Bachelor of Environmental Management (Honours) (BEnvMan(Hons))

1 Definitions

In these rules—

pre-2019 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2019;

pre-2021 student means a student who first enrolled in the program after 31 December 2018 but before 1 January 2021.

2 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units from the BEnvMan(Hons) course list, comprising—
 - (a) 46 units for core courses, and
 - (b) either—
 - (i) 12 units of research courses, or
 - (ii) 4 units of industry courses and 8 units of level 3 elective courses, and
 - (c) 2-6 units of program elective courses, and
 - (d) 0-4 units of general elective courses.
- (2) A student must complete no more than 24 units of level 1 courses.

3 Maximum credit for other study

The associate dean (academic) may only grant 8 units of credit towards courses at level 3 or higher, on the basis of prior study.

4 Special rules

4.1 Progression through program

To enrol in the research courses, a student must have—

- (a) completed 40 units of core courses in rule 2(1)(a), with a GPA of 5.5; or
- (b) gained permission of the head of school.

5 Transitional

- (1) A student enrolled in the Bachelor of Environmental Management as at 31 December 2014 may be permitted to enrol in this program.
- (2) A pre-2019 student may choose to complete the program under the rules in force on 31 December 2018. For students entering the program after 1 January 2019 with credit for other study, the executive dean may require the student to enrol under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2018.
- (3) A pre-2021 student may choose to complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2020.
