

Bachelor of Social Work (Honours)(BSocWk(Hons))

1 Definitions

In these rules—

minor means a prescribed combination of 8 units;

practicum course means a course containing a practical component where students gain supervised experience in a workplace setting;

pre-2018 student means a student who first enrolled in the program before 1 January 2018.

2 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units from the BSocWk(Hons) course list, including a minor.

3 Class of honours

The class of honours is calculated on the basis of the GPA over 16 units of courses identified in the BSocWk(Hons) course list.

4 Special rules

4.1 Credit cancellation period

The credit cancellation period for the BSocWk(Hons) program is 7 years after gaining credit for SWSP2077.

4.2 Practicum

A student who commences but does not successfully complete a practicum course may re-enrol in that course only if approved by the executive dean.

4.3 Blue card

Prior to the start of placement courses, and if required, a student must obtain a blue card and thereafter hold a current blue card for the duration of the program.

4.4 Award of the Bachelor of Welfare Studies

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 48 units in years 1-3 may be awarded the Bachelor of Welfare Studies.

4.5 Transitional

A pre-2018 student may be permitted to complete the program under the current rules or the rules in force on 31 December 2017.
