

Bachelor of Mathematics / Bachelor of Arts (BMath/BA)

1 Definitions

In these rules—

BA extended major means a prescribed combination of 24 units from the plans section of the BA course list;

BA major means a prescribed combination of 16 units from the plans section of the BA course list;

BA minor means a prescribed combination of 8 units from the plans section of the BA course list;

BMath major means a prescribed combination of 16 units from the major section of the BMath course list;

BMath minor means a prescribed combination of 8 units from the minor section of the BMath course list.

2 Program requirements

- (1) To complete the program, a student must complete 64 units, comprising—
 - (a) 32 units from the BMath course list, comprising—
 - (i) 12 units for core courses, and
 - (ii) 16 units for a BMath major, and
 - (iii) 4 units from the BMath course list; and
 - (b) 32 units from the BA course list, comprising—
 - (i) two majors, or
 - (ii) both—
 - (A) 24 units for an extended major,
 - (B) 8 units for a minor.
- (2) Unless a different intention appears in these rules, a student must comply with the program rules for both constituent degrees.

3 Program plan

A student may not undertake the Mathematics major or minor in the BA component of the dual program.
