Bachelor of Business Management Requirements:

- 36 units from the BBusMan List including
 - 24 units of compulsory courses from Group 1; and
 - Either:
 - 12 units from one major in Group 2 (minimum 6 units must be at level 3); OR
 - 12 units of elective courses from Group 3 (minimum 6 units must be at level 3, and maximum 2 units may be at level 1).

Bachelor of Journalism Requirements:

- ✤ 32 units in accordance with the BJ Program List including
 - 24 units from Part A
 - 8 units from Part B
