It is important that you read and understand the following information.

To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. You may have to swap courses in the plan to allow you to finish with your desired major/s - please check prerequisites and semester offerings at <https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/>. You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. Please note: Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program comprising -

- 26 units of compulsory courses from Part A of the BBusMan and BIHTM Lists (not including TOUR2010); and
- 12 units for one major in Part B of the BBusMan List (6 units must be at level 3); and
- 12 units for one major in Part B of the BIHTM List (6 units must be at level 3); and
- 12 units for either –
 - a second major in Part B of the BBusMan List; or
 - a second major in Part B of the BIHTM List; or
 - elective courses from Part B or C or a combination of both from the BBusMan and/or BIHTM Lists; and
- 2 units of general elective courses from the BBusMan List or the BIHTM List or from almost any other undergraduate program in the University as approved by the Executive Dean.

Excluding Part A courses, no more than 4 units may be from level 1 courses.
