To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. Please note: Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 88 units for the program comprising –

- 32 units from the BCom list including –
 - 14 units of compulsory courses from Part A (not including LAWS1100); and
 - 12 units from one major in Part B (at least 6 units must be from level 3 courses); and
 - 6 units from Part B or C or a combination of both (no more than 4 units may be at level 1); and
- 40 units of compulsory courses from Part A of the LLB(Hons) list; and
- 16 units of elective courses from Part B of the LLB(Hons) list. LAWS5144 must be included if taking an Accounting major (for professional accreditation purposes).
