

Bachelor of Business Management/ Bachelor of Commerce 2020 Dual Program Structure

It is important that you read and understand the following information.

To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each section of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. You may have to swap courses in the plan to allow you to finish with your desired majors - please check prerequisites and semester offerings at <https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/>. You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. Please note: *If you choose to graduate early with one component of a dual degree, you must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Should you wish to complete the other component of the original dual degree, you will then be required to follow that single degree rules and **maximum credit rules** will apply.*

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program comprising -

- 24 units of compulsory courses from Part A of the BBusMan and BCom Lists (not including ACCT1101 and FINM1416); and
 - 12 units for one major in Part B of the BBusMan List (at least 6 units must be from level 3 courses); and
 - 12 units for one major in Part B of the BCom List (at least 6 units must be from level 3 courses); and
 - 12 units for either –
 - a second major in Part B of the BBusMan List; or
 - a second major in Part B of the BCom List; or
 - elective courses from Part B or C or a combination of both from the BBusMan and/or BCom Lists; and
 - 4 units of general elective courses from Part B or C or a combination of both from the BBusMan and/or BCom Lists or from almost any other undergraduate program in the University as approved by the Executive Dean.
- You may only include a **maximum of 4 units of Level 1 courses** (excluding Part A courses) towards the program.
