

Bachelor of Business Management / Bachelor of Education (Secondary) 2021 Dual Degree Program Structure

Please ensure you read and understand the following important information about your program.

The Bachelor of Business Management/Bachelor of Education (Secondary) program is a four year preservice teacher qualification that develops specialist teachers across the year levels 7 – 12 (secondary schooling phase).

It is your responsibility to ensure that you complete the requirements for each section of your program, in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The Bachelor of Business Management/Bachelor of Education (Secondary) dual program consists of two parts. The Bachelor of Business Management provides the content knowledge for two curriculum areas offered in schools, whilst the Bachelor of Education (Secondary) provides the skills, knowledge and practical experience required for teaching.

The core courses of the Bachelor of Business Management prepare students for teaching areas in Business (junior high school) and Business Organisation Management – BOM (senior high school). BBusMan/BEd(Sec) students must choose the BBusMan Part B major Business Economics to meet the prerequisites of a second teaching area – Economics (senior high school).

Please note: if you are admitted into this dual degree program mid-year or obtain partial credit you will need to ensure that you structure your program so that you are able to enter the final year of Bachelor of Education (Secondary) component in semester one – the final year of the BEd(Sec) program is a year-long professional year commencing in semester 1 only.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Bachelor of Business Management (BBusMan) Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units from the BBusMan List including -
 - 16 units of compulsory courses from Part A; and
 - 16 units for the Business Economics major in Part B.

Bachelor of Education (Secondary) (BEd(Sec)) Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units from the Bachelor of Education (Secondary) list including -
 - 16 units for core courses; and
 - 8 units for professional year courses; and
 - 8 units from professional year curriculum studies courses.

The BEd(Sec) Core teaches issues pertinent to teaching and schooling and is completed in conjunction with the requirements of the BBusMan degree.

The BEd(Sec) Professional Year Core and Curriculum courses develop professional expertise required for teaching. It must be taken fulltime and can only be commenced when BBusMan and BEd(Sec) Core course requirements have been met.

This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year. You are advised to check the scheduling for the current year and contact the relevant Faculty for advice if course scheduling has changed.
