Exiting Early

Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree.

Program Requirements

1. To complete the program, a student must complete 80 units comprising—
 - (a) 32 units from the BCompSc component, comprising—
 - (i) 16 units from Compulsory courses; and
 - (ii) 16 units for either:
 - (A) a BCompSc major; or
 - (B) no major comprising—
 - (a) 2 units for the Computer Science Extension course; and
 - (b) 8 units from Computer Science Introductory Electives; and
 - (c) 6 units from Computer Science Advanced Electives; and
 - (b) 48 units from the LLB(Hons) component comprising—
 - (i) 36 units for part A; and
 - (ii) 12 units from part B.
