Students exiting early with one component of a dual degree must complete the single degree requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single degree rules to complete the remaining component from that dual degree.

Program Requirements

You must complete a total of 64 units for the program.

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- 32 units from BA List (courses listed under BA majors) including either
 - o Two majors of 16 units each; or
 - o One extended major of 24 units plus a BA minor of 8 units

Bachelor of Tourism, Hospitality and Event Management Requirements:

- 32 units from the BTHEM List including
 - 16 units for all BTHEM Core Courses; and
 - 16 units for one Major from BTHEM Majors

To ensure you are meeting the requirements, you should refer to the Program Rules found on UQ's <u>Programs and Courses</u> website for the program, within the 'Courses and requirements' button.
