## Program Requirements

### Master of International Relations Requirements:

- 16 units from the MIR course list including
  - 8 units for all MIR Core Courses, and
  - 6 units from MIR Flexible Core Courses, and
  - 2 units from MIR Flexible Core and/or MIR Program Elective Courses

### Master of International Law Requirements:

- 16 units from the MIL course list including –
  - 8 units for all MIL Core Courses; and
  - 8 units from MIL Program Elective Courses
