<u>Please note:</u> Students exiting early with one component of a dual program must complete the single program requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single program requirements to complete the remaining component from that dual program and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 64 units, comprising -

- 14 units for all BBusMan Core Courses for the BBusMan/BEcon; and
- 16 units for all BEcon Core Courses; and
- 16 units for a BBusMan major (excluding the Business Economics major*); and
- 16 units from the BEcon component, comprising either -
 - one BEcon major (8 units must be at level 3); or
 - o BEcon Flexible Core Courses (8 units must be at level 3); and
- 2 units of general elective courses

You are not permitted to take the Business Economics major as part of this dual program
