It is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each component of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal.

Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a field of study, major, extended major, specialisation, minor or extended minor.

Ensure the plans for your program are correctly listed in <u>mySI-net</u>. If you require assistance selecting your plan(s), follow these <u>instructions</u>.

You may need to amend this plan depending on your choice of major.

Exiting Early

Students exiting early with one component of a dual program must complete the single program requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single program requirements to complete the remaining component from that dual program.

Global Experience

If you are planning on completing an overseas exchange, you may have to amend this plan. Students who would like an exchange experience in their program are encouraged to seek advice from their respective faculties early in their program (for BEL Faculty, contact International Mobility Team on exchange@bel.uq.edu.au and BEL Student Administration Team on bel@uq.edu.au; for the Faculty of Science, contact the Science Student Administration Team on <u>enquire@science.uq.edu.au</u>). Program Requirements

The Program Rules outline the requirements to complete the dual program and should be read in conjunction with the course list for each component of the dual program. Please refer to the <u>program and course requirements</u> for more information.

You must complete 64 units comprising:

Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) component:

- 32 units from the BCom course list including
 - o 16 units for all BCom Core Courses; and
 - o 16 units for one Major from BCom Majors

AND (continue on page 2)



Bachelor of Science (BSc) component:

- 32 units from the BSc List, with a minimum of 10 units of courses at level 3 or higher, including
 - o 4 units for all BSc Core Courses; and
 - o Either
 - 28 units from BSc Major option, or
 - 28 units from BSc Extended Major option

Cross-listed Courses

A course can only count towards one dual program component. If the course is compulsory in one program, it must be counted towards that program component and you should select another course from the other course list at the same level or higher. If a course is compulsory in both programs, you may select which program it will count towards, and select another course at the same level or higher from the other program course list. For courses selected from the BSc course list, this does not include courses in the UQ minors list. Please check the special rules for the dual program as they may outline specific requirements for course substitutions.

Regardless of any possible cross-listing between programs, to meet the program requirements for the BSc component of your dual program, each:

- major must include 8 units of courses level 3 or higher,
- extended major must contain 12 units of courses at level 3 or higher, and
- minor must contain 4 units of courses at level 2 or higher

taken from and counting only towards that plan's course list.

Course Scheduling

This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year. You are advised to check the scheduling for the current year and contact the relevant faculty for advice if course scheduling has changed.

c) Only 2 units of prerequisite courses.
