



## This Program Planner is for Bachelors of Criminology and Criminal Justice/Arts (BCCJ/BA) students starting in 2024

### Important Information

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a **program** and a subject as a **course**.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a **full-time student**, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program.

### BCCJ/BA Program Requirements

Your BCCJ/BA comprises 64 units that you will complete over four years.

#### Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice (BCCJ) component requirements:

- Complete **32 units** comprising -
  - **28 units** for all BCCJ Core Courses; AND
  - **4 units** from BCCJ Flexible Core Courses.

#### Bachelor of Arts (BA) component requirements:

- Complete **32 units** from either of the two options –
  - Option 1 – Two BA Majors (16 units each); OR
  - Option 2 – One BA Extended Major (24 units) and one BA Minor (8 units)

Please note: Due to course overlap with the BCCJ component, a student cannot undertake the Criminology Major or Legal Education Studies Majors or Minors in the BA component of the dual program.

### Global Experience

Students who wish to undertake on overseas exchange should start planning early in their program. Please note that the BCCJ(Hons) Core Courses CRIM3201 (Sem 1) and CRIM3202 (Sem 2) must be taken on campus at UQ, in consecutive semesters. Students requiring assistance with planning for exchange should contact the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. ### Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a Minor (8 units), Major (16 units), or Extended Major (24 units). Ensure the plans for your program are correctly listed in [mySI-net](#). If you require assistance selecting your plan(s), follow these [instructions](#).

### Exiting Early

Students exiting early with one component of a dual program must complete the single program requirements. Students will then be required to follow the single program rules to complete the remaining component of that dual program.

This Program Planner assists you in drafting an enrolment plan to complete the requirements of a BCCJ/BA dual as a full-time student over four years.
