PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 80 units, comprising –

- 32 units from the BEcon component, including
 - o 16 units for all BEcon Core Courses; and either
 - 16 units for one BEcon major (8 units must be at level 3); or
 - 16 units from BEcon Flexible Core Courses (8 units must be at level 3); and
- 48 units from the LLB(Hons) component, including
 - o 36 units from LLB(Hons) Core Courses; and
 - 12 units from LLB(Hons) Flexible Core Courses
