It is important that you read and understand the following information.

To be eligible to enrol in a dual degree program you must ensure that you satisfy the entry requirements for both programs.

Once enrolled it is your responsibility to ensure that you complete all the requirements for each component of this dual program in order to graduate with both degrees. The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment to meet this goal. You may have to swap courses in the plan to allow you to finish with your desired major/s - please check prerequisites and semester offerings at <https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/>. You are not required to submit this program plan for approval. Please note: Students exiting early with one component of a dual program must complete the single program requirements of that component. Students will then be required to follow the single program requirements to complete the remaining component from that dual program and maximum credit rules will apply.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete 64 units, comprising –

- 20 units for all BBusMan/BCom Core Courses; and
- 16 units for one BBusMan Major; and
- 16 units for one BCom Major; and
- 12 units for General Elective Courses

Note:

Selected courses must include at most 28 units at level 1.

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3 for the program and at least 4 units at level 3 for each major.
