Program Requirements

The Program Requirements outline the requirements to complete the dual program and should be read in conjunction with the course list for each component of the dual program. Please refer to the <u>program and course requirements</u> for more information.

You must complete 64 units comprising:

Bachelor of Business Management (BBusMan) component:

- Students must 32 units comprising:
 - o 16 units for all BBusMan Core Courses; and
 - o 16 units for one major from BBusMan Majors

Bachelor of Design (BDes) component:

• Student must complete 28 units of BDes Core Courses and 4 units of BDes Program Elective Courses or General Elective Courses.

Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a field of study, major, extended major, specialisation, minor or extended minor.

Course Scheduling

Exiting Early
